Beatitudes

Beatitudes – latin for blessed.

Blessed - Gift from God that includes: happiness, human flourishing, thriving, goodness, and peace.

Blessed - Relationship to the Biblical Story

Gen 1 – God <u>blessed</u> them and said, Be fruitful and multiply

Gen 12:1-3 "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

Blessed – God's favor is upon you. God is on your side.

Story of Mary – Luke 1 28 The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you."

41 When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting... she exclaimed: "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear!

Blessed

Blessing is both a present reality and a future promise.

- 1st for theirs is the kingdom of God.
- 2nd for they will be comforted
- 3rd for they will inherit the earth
- 4th for they will be filled
- 5th for they will be shown mercy
- 6th for they will see God
- 7th for they will be called children of God
- 8th for theirs is the kingdom of God

Lord's Prayer



First Beatitude – Poor in Spirit "Blessed are the <u>poor in spirit</u>, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

"Blessed are you <u>who are poor,</u> for yours is the kingdom of God. (Luke 6:20)

Q: Blessed are the <u>poor</u> or blessed are the <u>poor in spirit</u>?

Q: Who are the poor in spirit?

Second Beatitude – Those who mourn Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

Isa 61:1-4 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, ... to comfort all who mourn ... the oil of joy instead of mourning

Third Beatitude – The meek
Blessed are the meek,
for they will inherit the earth.

Meek – endure suffering and injury without revenge. Non-violent.

Matt 11:29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and (meek, KJV) humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Third Beatitude – The meek Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

Psalm 37:10-11

10A little while, and the wicked will be no more; though you look for them, they will not be found.

11 But the meek will inherit the land and enjoy peace and prosperity.

Fourth Beatitude

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.

God's Righteousness – God's perfect holiness.
Includes his justice. God's moral character.
Our Righteous life – our moral and ethical behaviour.

Blessed

Blessed are ...

Fifth Beatitude - The merciful

7 Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

Micah 6:8

He has shown you, O mortal, what is good.
And what does the Lord require of you?

To act justly and to love mercy
and to walk humbly with your God.

Sixth Beatitude – Pure in Heart Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

Psalm 24:3-4
3Who may ascend the mountain of the Lord?
Who may stand in his holy place?
4 The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god.

Seventh Beatitude – The peacemakers
Blessed are the peacemakers,
for they will be called children of God.

Psalm 85:10

Love and faithfulness meet together;

righteousness and peace kiss each other.

Eighth Beatitude – The persecuted

Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness,

for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
